10th AcE-Bs2022Cherating: Keynote Speaker



João Pedro Teixeira de Abreu Costa

is an Architect (TU Lisbon, 1993), with Master on Contemporary Architectonic Culture (TU Lisbon, 1998) and PhD on Urbanism (TU Catalonia, Barcelona, 2007). His post-PhD is on Architecture and Urbanism (TU Lisbon, 2011). He was promoted to full professor (Agregação) in Urbanism (ULisbon, 2012).

He is Associate Professor of Urbanism at the Faculty of Architecture, University of Lisbon, where he develops his teaching, research and expertise activity, and member of the Direction Board of the CIAUD – Research Centre of Architecture, Urbanism and Design, as well as a Visiting Professor at the Superior Institut of Agronomy, University of Lisbon (Landscape Architecture Master Degree).

From 2002 to 2004 he was advisor and head of cabinet of the Portuguese Secretary of State for Spatial Planning. He has been the director of the Portuguese professional journal *Arquitecturas*, from 2005 to 2016.

He currently develops the research activity through coordination and participation in international teams and networks in the areas of adaptation to climate change, urban planning and spatial planning policies and urban morphology; which combines with the university extension, of having as the most recent reference is the coordination of the Territorial Planning Plan of the Island of Ataúro (2016), the first territorial plan ever to be approved in the history of Timor-East, a former Portuguese colony in South East Asia.

In the 2017 municipal elections in Portugal, he was candidate to Vice-President of the City of Lisbon, by the Social Democrat Party, being today a Councilman in the opposition at the City Council (without executive functions).

Nicholas Kathijotes

studied civil engineering at the University of Massachusetts, in U.S.A (1976). Granted a Fulbright scholarship, he received his Master's degree in Environmental Engineering at the University of New Haven, Connecticut, U.S.A (1986). He did his doctoral research at the University of Architecture, Civil Engineering and

Geodesy - UACEG in Sofia studying the effects of wastewater recycling on various soils. He received his PhD in 2001.

He is a professor in the Department of Civil Engineering at the Cyprus University of Technology since 2008. He was also elected as Adjunct Professor at the 'Nikola Poushkarov Institute of Soil Science' in Sofia.

His research interests are in the areas of sustainable use of water resources, wastewater reuse and coastal protection and management with emphasis on the developing countries.

In 2008 he was appointed by the International Ocean Institute Headquarters as the Focal Point of the International Ocean Institute for Cyprus. In this capacity he is coordinating all activities of IOI (Cyprus), hosted by the Cyprus University of Technology. He has considerable research activity towards the evaluation and elimination of nutrients due to human activities in ground and coastal waters.

In 2011 he was honored by the 'N. Poushkarov Institute of Soil Science' for his contribution to the protection of soil resources in Bulgaria and the World.

He coordinated and was involved in various projects as follows:-

NOVIWAM FR7 EU Project on Water Resources, "Treatment Technology and Application of Domestic Solid Wastes", "Industrial and Agricultural Wastes of Fertilizers", "Reclamation Of Disturbed Terrain", "Technological Evaluation of the Effectiveness of Organic Wastes for use in Agriculture", "Agro ecological evaluation of Wastewater Sludge and Organic Manure for Use in Agriculture", and aquaculture monitoring

He is also a member of the Editorial Board of the 'Asean Journal of Environment-Behaviour Studies and member of the 'Borneo Science' - International Advisory Board, as well as member of the 'Association of Malaysian Environment-Behaviour Researchers' AMER. He reviews scientific articles for the 'Academy Sains Malaysia (ASM) – Journal', IWA, IASTED and others.

He was invited as expert on environmental issues in various developing countries, by UNEP, IOI-Thailand, 'State Oceanic Association-China', EAS, and others.

Author of over 100 scientific articles, many of which related to developing countries, in International Journals, book sections, and conference proceedings.
